### Validating the Action Plan for the National Qualifications Framework (NQF) Implementation for 2016-2020 in Ukraine

5 July 2016

#### Rationale

The NQF is a central part of the education and training reform in Ukraine. It was adopted in 2011, while an action plan for NQF Implementation covered the period 2012-2015. According to a preliminary assessment, less than 20.0% of actions in the plan have been implemented. A new plan for 2016-2020 is foreseen to be adopted as part of the “100 days” reform programme of the government. The draft Plan has been elaborated with the involvement of all the stakeholders and is going to be presented and discussed during the seminar to make sure that everybody understands what has been proposed and what is expected of everybody over the next five years. After the seminar, the draft Plan will be completed and submitted, under the established procedure, for its adoption to the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine.
